Dr. Michael LeFebvre's book *The Liturgy of Creation: Understanding Calendars in Old Testament Context*, his article Adam Reigns in Eden, and his recent posting on hte Biologos website (https:biologos.org/articles/cracking-the-code-of-cadence-the-genre-of-genesis) to ascertain whether or not these writings are consistent with the subordinate standards of the RPCNA... [and] to forward their conclusions to this Presbytery." The committee was instructed by the AIC to "determine how the Communication should be handled, and to return recommendations to Presbytery." **NOTE**: The clerk apologizes for originally forwarding Communication 19-5 to the AIC with the incorrect designation *Communication 19-4*. This designation (19-4) had previously been applied to a paper on confessional subscription which Dr. LeFebvre had submitted to the court immediately following the mid-morning break on Friday 3/1/19 in Orlando.
