(Great Basin RPC) Reno, NV: The Ad Interim (Brea) took over as the TGB in September. Rev. Sawtelle reported that since then attendance has been in the mid-twenties, giving is above what is budgeted, Rev. Samul is laboring there.

<u>Las Vegas</u>: This work has been seven years without a pastor. The presence of new visitors is very encouraging. Attendance remained strong in the 30s-40s each week.
