

Petition for Dissolution to the Presbytery for Reformed Presbyterian Church of Selma

Dear Great Lakes-Gulf Presbytery,

Please accept this letter as formal notification that Reformed Presbyterian Church of Selma, located at 627 J. L. Chestnut Jr. Blvd (formerly Jeff Davis Avenue), has voted to dissolve as a legal corporation, effective date 5/3/26.

This decision was reached after careful prayer and a formal vote of the congregation on January 12, 2026. It was determined that realistically, we cannot afford to maintain a church with the numbers we have; when it comes to compensation for a pastor, utilities, building maintenance, materials, furnishings, etc. We cannot solely rely on an endowment to cover for us from year to year without increasing the number of our parishioners, and we don't see that happening here in this city.
